In 2011, Carole's House of Hope, incorporated (CHH) was established as an organization purposed to transform the lives of young women aging out of the foster care system, pregnant or parenting mothers and their children.

CHH address' the gaps in the current model of service that can inevitably lead to high rates of unemployment, poverty, homelessness, mental health instability, criminal activity, early pregnancy, human trafficking and prostitution. CHH is intentional on creating a safe place in which women can stabilize, heal and lay the ground work for future endeavors while becoming self-sufficient. Carole's House of Hope provides housing, pantry food items, clothing for the young ladies and children, diapers/wipes, community engagement opportunities, transportation and bus passes to personal appointments when able.

To combat the issue of cyclical homelessness our organization has created partnerships with community programs to conduct weekly groups on campus. Topics such as Financial Literacy, Building Healthy Relationships, Parenting Skills, Circle of Security with Nebraska Children's Home Society, Cooking Matters, Domestic Violence Awareness/Prevention in conjunction with Individual and Group Counseling are offered. Carole's House of Hope promotes setting educational goals and assists with High School Diploma/GED completion, College enrollment, and completion of financial aid paperwork for ladies choosing to attain a higher education.
